

\$1000 Reward for Information

In 1996, Tyrone Noling was sentenced to death for the murders of **Cora and Bernhardt Hartig**. The murders took place in early April 1990 at the Hartig's home on Moff Road in Atwater, Ohio. Mr. Noling refused to plead guilty in exchange for a shorter sentence. He was convicted of the murders without any physical evidence linking him to the scene of the crime. **Furthermore, the .25 caliber automatic handgun used in the murders has never been found. It is believed to be a Titan, F.I.E., E.I.G., or Hawes-model firearm.** Mr. Noling has maintained his innocence while serving on death row for the last 13 years. He now depends on the public for information that may save his life.

Attorneys for Tyrone Noling are offering \$1000 reward to the first person to come forward with information that results in Mr. Noling's exoneration and release from prison.
