That I received information from an anonymous source that John Trandifir Jr., has been staying alone at 421 Bonnieview for about the past week, since his father was involved in an accident at Ely & Union and was hospitalized. Since that time, Gary St. Clair, Joey Dalesandro, Tyrone Noling, and " Butch " ( LNU from Akron have been staying at the Trandifir residence. StClair is allegedly in possession of a stolen credit card, and there is supposed to be a stolen CR, in a suitcase, in a bedroom closet. There are also allegedly stolen bikes in a bedroom.

This officer and Ptl. Blake placed the residence under surveillance on 4-8-90, early evening hours, and there was lots of activity, persons in and out, etc. at the residence. It appeared that the residence was being cleaned, several bags of trash set out, dishes being done, etc. possibly for the return of John Trandifir Sr. Two vehicles were seen, a light blue Olds, 4S,78, reg. 447/XKN ( printout attached ) and a dark colored Z-28 or similar model, with a loud muffler. The registration on this vehicle could not be obtained, and possibly it had a temp. tag as no plate could be seen on the rear, but we were observing from a distance. A subject who may have been Noling assisted a female in pushing a small light blue Escort type vehicle about the driveway.

Possibly 3rd shift could check through trash which has been set out in the early morning hours, for any possible related evidence to these robberies/burglaries.
