The subjects were driving a blue 78 Olds,, belonging to a Fred Dalesandro, when committing the robberies in Alliance.

The weapons used were a 177 Crossman Pellet band gun and a Sawed-off shotgun.

Det. Muchlo will forward pictures and any information they have on Joe Dalesandro and Tyrone Noling and pictures of the car. A third subject involved and in custody is a Gary Sinclair, from the Akron area.

It is felt that these subjects were also involved in the armed robberies in the Country Quick Stop in October and the Hy-Miler in December.

The residence was checked on several occasions by several officers, the car was there.

On Friday, April 20th, 1990, Det. Kaley stated they were coming to Fulton County to interview Joe Delasandro. At 7:00 p.m. interview was conducted.

On 12-18-89 at approximately 21:38 hours an armed robbery occurred at the Hy-Miler Truck Stop located at 8110-SR108, Wauseon, Ohio. The vehicle was parked on the south side of the business. Two subjects entered the store and one subject produced a pump action shotgun. This suspect chambered a round into the weapon and aimed it at the cashier's son and ordered him to go to the front of the store. The second suspect had a plastic K-Mart bag with handles and ordered the cashier to put the money in the bag.

Both suspect's left in a car that was waiting occupied by an unknown suspect north bound on SR108. Deputy Stickley was at Ottokee at this time and during responding to the scene passed we believe the suspect's vehicle eastbound on Cr J. The vehicle shut its headlights off and later turned them back on and proceeded eastbound on Cr J. The vehicle was lost then. R/O observed one possible tennis shoe print where the gunman was standing. This was photographed. A written statement was obtained from a truck driver that was present during the robbery. Taped statements were obtained from both other victims. Victim believes vehicle has been there before and had drove around the building several times earlier same date.

VEHICLE: Possibly a GM product, robin egg blue, 2 door. (note: color may be off due to tinted business windows). Dark possibly blue molding or stripes running up and down behind rear passenger window from top of car to trunk level. See sketch. Possible blue interior.

SHOTGUN: Pump action, blued, wood stock, and forearm long barrel.

SUSPECT #1: Bag Man
Approximately 6'1" slender build black or dark ski mask, glasses, blue jeans, dark coat. Bag was a plastic K-Mart bag with handles. Suspect was wearing gloves.

SUSPECT #2: Gunman
Approximately 6'1" slender build black or dark ski mask. Possible white tennis shoes (maybe Converse)

SUSPECT #3: Unknown - remained in car. Also had ski mask.

Search Warrant

A search warrant was obtained by this Officer on 04-11-90 for the residence located @ 421 Bonnieview St. Alliance, Ohio. The following items were taken into evidence as a result of the search: 1 red rubber Halloween mask, 1 Strider instruction manual, 1 plastic game case, and 1 Game boy tetris instruction booklet. The following people were present during the Search: Detective M.R. Dailey, Detective W.N. Mucklo., Clerk of Courts, Jo Ann Burr, Independent Witness, Gary Search.

I had contacted Deputy Dave S. Hoste of the Fulton County Sheriffs Department by public service in reference to Joey Dalesandro and Tyrone Noling. I had gained information from the Marlboro Police Department that Noling and Dalesandro may have been involved in several home burglaries in the Fulton County area. Joey Dalesandro's Father, Fred Dalesandro, lives @ 4925 US 20 A. S. Ma, Ohio in Fulton County. Deputy Hoste stated that his Department was investigating several aggravated robberies of local convenience stores where the suspects covered their facial features with rubber Halloween masks and made their getaway in a large robin egg blue colored vehicle. The vehicle was a 4 dr. GM product, according to witnesses. The aforementioned vehicle description matches the automobile that Joey Dalesandro is presently driving, a blue 1978 4 dr. oldsmobile, registration 447-XKN. On 4-09-90, upon gaining a consent to search 421 Bonnieview St. Alliance, Ohio. from Gary St. Clair, I remember observing a red rubber Halloween mask laying on the floor of the residence. I also observed about eight Nintendo game tapes laying on the floor of the residence near the television set. A Colt Moviewalker VCR Sr# S-911200310

The Halloween mask that was recovered from 421 Bonnieview St. along with photographs of Joey Dalesandro's vehicle (registration 447-XKN) and information on Joey Dalesandro, Tyrone Noling, and Gary St. Clair was sent to Deputy Hoste to aid in his investigation.

Further investigation into the Colt Moviewalker VCR that was taken as evidence from 421 Bonnieview St. on 04-09-90 shows that the item belongs to Video Safari, 1800 Bl. of W. State St. The VCR, along with eight nintendo game tapes had been rented on ~~04-02-90~~ under the name of Jim Vogel. The tapes and the VCR were never returned. It should be noted that Mr. Vogel's vehicle had been broken into around the last week of March and his wallet had been stolen. The suspects had taken Mr. Vogel's Safari video ID card and rented the VCR and Nintendo tapes. In speaking with Tyrone noling 04-18-90, he advised me That Butch Walrath had rented the VCR and Nintendo tapes and that Joey Dalesandro had waited in his vehicle for him. At the time of the search warrant on 04-11-90, all of the Nintendo game tapes had been taken from the residence @ 421 Bonnieview, unknown whereabouts. Please refer to the attached list for names of the Nintendo tapes. All that was obtained in the search was a plastic nintendo game case along with the instruction manual to the Stride Nintendo game. Safari Video did identify the plastic game case as being
