On July 29, 1992, at approximately 6:15 p.m., Chief Detective Duane W. Kaley, Lt. Don Doak, Attorney John Noble, and Joseph Dalesandro left Alliance, Ohio for the purpose of Mr. Dalesandro identifying the Hartig residence.

Chief Det. Duane Kaley was driving the vehicle. The route taken was as follows: Bonnieview in Alliance making a right hand turn onto Main, followed Main to the intersection of Lincoln where a left turn was made. Followed Lincoln to vine, making a left turn onto Vine, Right off of Vine onto Rock Hill, which led to a left hand turn on St. Rt. 183. We followed Rail road tracks along 183, eventually making a left on 224 in Atwater. We turned right off of 224 onto Industry which led us to Moff Road.

Chief Kaley drove up and down Moff Road several times. At no time could Mr. Dalesandro identify the residence of the Hartigs. Mr. Dalesandro did comment that he remembered the house having Pine trees and large rocks in the yard. The Hartig residence does have both, however he was not able to recognize the residence.
