Mr. St. Clair was again told not to sa	ay anything until he had been read his	
Constitutional rights by Mr. Craig. Mr.	. St. Clair then became quite belligerent	
and volatile. He errupted from his chai	ir, headed for the door and begain pounding	юn
the door. He began saying he wasn't say	ying nothing and he wanted his attorney. A	fter
a couple of seconds, which it took that	long to open the door, he being noteably	_
shaken went out to a large waiting area	where he again said to Mr. Myers he wanted	
his attorney and he did not want to talk	k to us.	
At this point, Mr. St. Clair, when the	e guards arrived after being summoned by	
Mr. Myers took Gary to another office.
