**Narrative:**

On ~~7/28/92~~, Chief Criminal Prosecutor, Robert A. Durst and Investigator Ron Craig of the Portage County Prosecutor's Office traveled to Orient Correctional Institution to interview Gary St. Clair.

On arrival we met with Mr. Bob Myers the investigator at the facility who coordinated the interview.

At approximately 2:12 p.m. in a room at the facility Mr. St. Clair was introduced to us. Mr. Durst and Investigator Craig identified themselves and Mr. Durst told Gary St. Clair the reason for the interview.

Mr. Durst first told Gary not to make any statements, and the reason we were there he probably already knew. Mr. St. Clair shook his head yes but answered no. Mr. Durst explained we wished to talk to him about the homicide which took place in Portage County and he was going to be charged with two counts of Aggravated Murder.

Mr. St. Clair was again told not to say anything until he had been read his Constitutional rights by Mr. Craig. Mr. St. Clair then became quite belligerent and volatile. He erupted from his chair, headed for the door and began pounding on the door. He began saying he wasn't saying nothing and he wanted his attorney. After a couple of seconds, which it took that long to open the door, he being noticeably shaken went out to a large waiting area where he again said to Mr. Myers he wanted his attorney and he did not want to talk to us.

At this point, Mr. St. Clair, when the guards arrived after being summoned by Mr. Myers took Gary to another office.
