- 1 and walked up to the house and knocked on the
- 2 door.
- 3 Q. Who knocked on the door?
- 4 A. I'm not sure who knocked on the door.
- 5 Q. Just plural, "they" knocked on the
- 6 | door? Did they tell you, did Mr. Noling tell you
- 7 | if he had a weapon on him?
- 8 A. He had the 12 gauge.
- 9 Q. He had the 12 gauge?
- 10 A. Under his coat.
- 11 Q. Did anybody else have a weapon on them?
- 12 A. Gary had a BB gun.
- 13 | Q. Okay, and what did this BB gun look
- 14 like?
- 15 A. Little revolver.
- 16 | 0. Okay.
- 17 A. Just little revolver.
- 18 | Q. You go like this (indicating), was it
- 19 | little or big?
- 20 A. About, yea big, six inches maybe.
- 21 | Q. Okay. What did they tell you happened
- 22 when they approached the house?
- 23
- MR. CAHOON: Objection.
- 25 THE COURT: I think maybe you better

- 1 A. Yeah, pretty much.
- 2 Q. Did there come a time while you were
- 3 | staying on Bonnieview it was decided you weren't
- 4 | getting enough money from robbing the cars?
- 5 A. Not really. Just -- they, they was
- 6 | talking about doing robberies around there, you
- 7 know, that is how we got started.
- 8 Q. When you say "they", who are you
- 9 referring to?
- 10 A. Tyrone Noling.
- 11 Q. Anyone else talk about that?
- 12 A. Him and St. Clair, you know, they
- 13 | planned it, how they was going to rob.
- 14 Q. Joe, let me ask you a question, were
- 15 | there any guns or weapons at the Bonnieview
- 16 | address?
- 17 A. Tyrone bought a sawed off shotgun before
- 18 | he did them robberies, he bought it off Greg
- 19 | Pasquale.

- MR. CAHOON: Your Honor, excuse me, I'm
- 22 | going to object unless it's from personal
- 23 | knowledge.
- THE COURT: Overruled. You may
- 25 | proceed.

- 2 Q. Mr. Dalesandro, how do you know Mr.
- 3 | Noling bought a shotgun?
- 4 A. Because I was with him.
- 5 Q. And who did he purchase that from?
- 6 A. Greg Pasquale.
- 7 Q. Okay, can you describe that shotgun?
- 8 A. About like that. It was sawed off.
- 9 Q. Was it double barrel, single barrel?
- 10 A. Single. I think it was a single barrel,
- 11 yeah.
- 12 | Q. Do you recall when he may have purchased
- 13 | that shotgun?
- 14 A. I don't know any exact date.
- 15 Q. Okay. All right. Were there any other
- 16 | weapons or guns at Bonnieview during the time you
- 17 | stayed there?
- 18 A. A BB gun.
- 19 | Q. Okay. Any other weapons there?
- 20 A. Not that I remember at that time.
- 21 Q. All right. Did it come to pass some
- 22 | robberies were committed while you folks were
- 23 | staying at Bonnieview?
- 24 | A. Did it what?
- 25 Q. Were any robberies of any houses

- 1 Q. Was Mr. Wolcott involved in the Hughes
- 2 robbery?
- 3 A. No, we was all at the house, me, Johnny
- 4 and Butch Wolcott.
- 5 Q. What did you do, did you do anything
- 6 | later on after that robbery, that day?
- 7 A. I think we used to go to this one bar
- 8 that Tyrone used to go out -- somewhere outside of
- 9 Alliance. We went out there a few times, we was
- 10 | playing pool and stuff and they used to take their
  - 11 | guns. Tyrone had his gun all the time.
  - 12 Q. Which gun is that?
  - 13 | A. That little gun.
  - 14 | Q. So this is after the Hughes' robbery, is
  - 15 | that what you're indicating?
  - 16 A. We had the three guns. We had that
  - 17 | little gun he stole from the first house, the
  - 18 | sawed off shotgun and the BB gun.
  - 19 | Q. Did Mr. Noling have any bullets for the
  - 20 | qun taken from the Hughes residence?
  - 21 A. He got bullets somewhere. He had a
  - 22 | whole bunch of bullets.
  - 23 Q. Did there come a time another robbery of
  - 24 | another house occurred while staying on
  - 25 Bonnieview?

- 1 | other robberies?
- 2 A. He was talking about, he was going to
- 3 rob again.
- 4 Q. Okay. Was that conversation in the car?
- 5 A. Yeah.
- 6 Q. Do you know if Mr. Noling or anyone else
- 7 | in that car had any weapons?
- 8 A. Yeah, Tyrone had a gun. St. Clair had
- 9 that sawed-off shotgun, and then the BB gun was in
- 10 there, too.
- 11 Q. Do you know what type of gun Mr. Noling
- 12 | had?
- 13 A. Just a little gun, automatic.
- 14 Q. One of those with the clip in the
- 15 handle?
- 16 | A. Yeah, he had bullets, kept all his
- 17 | bullets and stuff in his bag.
- 18 | Q. What type of bag was that?
- 19 A. Like a vinyl bag, a little -- he used to
- 20 | carry it and put stolen stuff in there.
- 21 | Q. Okay. Mr. Dalesandro, as you were
- 22 | driving down the road, where was Mr. Noling
- 23 | sitting in the vehicle?
- 24 A. On the passenger side.
- 25 Q. Front seat or back?

- 1 Q. Okay. Can you see this? Okay.
- Okay, this is the back seat. So do you
- 3 | have any idea what is going on at this point?
- 4 A. Driving around basically, right then.
- 5 Q. Okay. Were you aware of any weapons in
- 6 the car?
- 7 A. It was the little .25 and 12 gauge was
- 8 in the car. Gary had the .25 or Tyrone had
- 9 | the .25 and Gary had the 12 gauge in the back.
- 10 Q. Okay. Now, was there -- did you
- 11 overhear any discussion in the car between Mr.
- 12 | Noling and anybody else?
- 13 A. They wanted to rob another house. They,
- 14 | as in Tyrone and Joey.
- 15 Q. Okay. Was there any discussion as to
- 16 | where you were going to go to do this?
- 17 A. Not that I remember.
- 18 | Q. Do you remember where you went?
- 19 A. Atwater.
- 20 | Q. Okay. Tell us what happened on the way
- 21 to Atwater.
- 22 | A. We just drove around really and ended up
- 23 | there.
- 24 | Q. Were you looking for anything in
- 25 | particular?

- 1 people.
- 2 | Q. Okay. What else did he say?
- 3 A. As far as I know that was it until we
- 4 | got to the house.
- 5 Q. Okay. Did he -- did he make any
- 6 statements about how you were going to rob these
- 7 | people?
- 8 A. Yes, he did.
- 9 Q. Now what statements were they?
- 10 A. Knock on the door, to tell the people we
- 11 | have a broken down car, we used the telephone to
- 12 | get inside.
- 13 Q. Now did you guys have any weapons?
- 14 A. Yes.
- 15 | Q. Would you tell the jury what weapons you
- 16 | had?
- 17 | A. I had a BB gun and Tyrone Noling had a
- 18 sawed off shotgun.
- 19 Q. Okay. Now, on April fourth of 1990,
- 20 | tell the jury what happened, what did you guys do?
- 21 A. On April fourth, about four thirty,
- 22 | quarter to five in the afternoon--

- MR. CAHOON: Excuse me, your Honor.
- 25 | I'll again renew the continuing objection.

- 1 | seen there was a little gun sitting on, I think it
- 2 | was the dresser and, for sure, and Tyrone seen him
- 3 | going for it. Tyrone spun the gun around --
- 4 Q. Spun who around?
- 5 A. Himself around with the gun, pointed the
- 6 | gun at Mrs. Hughes; if Mr. Hughes moves for the
- 7 | qun Tyrone was going to shoot her. I knew in my
- 8 head Tyrone wasn't going to shoot her because the
- 9 | qun wasn't loaded, the shotgun.
- 10 Q. So what happened?
- 11 | A. We left.
- 12 Q. Okay. Did you take anything?
- 13 A. Uhm, Tyrone, uhm, grabbed a .25
- 14 automatic from there, a VCR, some jewelry and some
- 15 money.
- 16 Q. Did you grab anything?
- 17 | A. Uh-uh. We got outside, Mr. Joseph
- 18 | Dalesandro was out back waiting for us.
- 19 Q. Out back, how do you mean?
- 20 A. The house.
- 21 | Q. He had a car, didn't he?
- 22 | A. Yeah.
- 23 Q. Do you remember what color that car was?
- 24 A. Blue. Blue car, four door.
- 25 Q. Did you use that car in this robbery?
